- Board Members work together to advance the goals, objectives and priorities of the organization and commit both the time and effort to board meetings and committee meetings, and are eligible to receive an honorarium for their time.
- Committee work may include, but is not limited to, organizing and/or chairing committee meetings on a regular or ad hoc basis to collect information or advance discussion on a specific issue to help support informed decision-making by the Board of Directors.
- Board Members regularly attend and participate in meetings, and Board Members strive for full participation throughout the year.
- DDC has two for-profit subsidiaries, Lightning Fire Management and Teslin Environmental Services, as part of a social enterprise model.
- As part of DDC's focus on Revitalization, our team works to deliver programs and services that support opportunity readiness and workforce development in the post-COVID economy. This includes working with partners on projects and initiatives that enhance local capacity, create employment, maximize participation in current/emerging opportunities and ultimately contribute to community well-being.
